Who is this workshop for? This workshop is designed for postdoctoral research and clinical fellows who are planning to submit or resubmit a K-award application in the upcoming February/March 2023 cycle. What will be covered in the workshop?

- 1. Individualized review and feedback on your Specific Aims page and Career Development plan
- 2. Small group activities to discuss K award application sections, including the Candidate Statement and Development Plan
- 3. Didactic and interactive sessions covering the following topics:
 - a. Candidate Background
 - b. Workshopping the K Award Specific Aims
 - c. The Career Development Plan
 - d. Meeting reviewer needs and expectations
 - e. The importance of tying it all together

Note: this workshop focusses on grant writing, not feedback on your science.
